Microsoft OneNote Classroom is designed to help teachers and students collaborate and communicate more effectively in the classroom. Students can access the notebooks from any device and use them to complete assignments, take notes, and collaborate with their classmates.

Allows teachers to create digital notebooks for their classes and share resources, assignments, and other materials with their students.

- Includes accessibility features such as text-to-speech, translation, and read-aloud options
- Allows to record audio and video notes, which can be played back later
- Supports the insertion of videos, web links, and Microsoft PowerPoint presentations
- Integration with other Microsoft tools

Main features:

Class notebook structure includes a structure that separates content into different sections for different purposes, such as a content library, a student notebook, and a collaboration space.

Note-taking features a range of tools for taking notes, including the ability to type, write by hand, and draw.

Task management allows teachers to assign tasks to individual students or groups and track their progress. Teachers can set due dates and add comments or feedback to student work.

Collaboration allows teachers to create a shared notebook for their class, where students can collaborate on projects. Teachers can control access to different sections of the notebook, and students can share their work.
